


Make a Life Cycle Necklace



Materials: Life Cycle Lily Pad Necklace printable from www.scholastic.com/lfo, crayons, scissors, glue, yarn, cut-up paper drinking straws

- **Pass** out the printables and let kids color the pictures.
- Next, help kids cut out their lily pads. Help kids fold back the tabs on the lily pads and staple or tape to make a loop. Provide lengths of yarn and cut-up drinking straws.
- From right to left, have kids thread the lily pads in sequence by life cycle stage, separating them with a cut straw. (If you have one, a childsafe threading needle can help.)
 When kids' necklaces are in order, tie around the back of each child's neck to fit. It's a fabulous froggie fashion statement!
